

This recipe is not only all natural and incredibly moisturizing to the lashes, but it contains a nutrient dense seaweed called bladderwrack for coloring, to help it dry AND to help nourish those lashes as well as castor oil which can actually help lashes grow.

Seaweed Mascara

Ingredients:

- 1 teaspoon activated charcoal, about 4-5 capsules
- 1/8 teaspoon bladderwrack powder
- 1/8 teaspoon vitamin E
- 1/2 tablespoon coconut oil
- 1 teaspoon beeswax
- 1 ¾ teaspoons castor oil
- Empty mascara tubes



Directions:

1. Combine all ingredients in a stove-top pan. Stir and warm till beeswax melts and mixes with the oils.
2. Pour the mixture into a plastic baggy, and force to one end (you want the mixture warm, but not too hot it will melt the baggy).
3. Make a tiny cut at one of the bottom corners of the baggy and squirt into the mascara tube. Put the stopper in place when finished.
4. Give mascara 30-60 minutes to thicken and set up before use, makes about 1 tube.

Note: Try to get it from stove top to mascara tube as fast as possible. If you wait too long the mascara will start to set up quickly making it very hard to get inside.
